Accommodation

The first thing that strikes you on entry from the cockpit to the saloon from the oversized stainless steel doors, is the feeling of space. The large port side sofa with panoramic windows behind, facing to the starboard side where the large TV appears on the rise and fall system, with the latest smart television linked to Bose surround sound. Moving further forward the starboard side large dining table with space for up to 8 with her large panoramic window, located adjacent to the port side Galley, with conveniently located wine fridge facing the dining area for ease of service.

The Galley bar large enough for serving but not too large to overpower the area conceals the rest of the Galley, with the large Miele Fridge and freezer, Miele dishwasher and new Siemens oven and induction hob. Further forward is the helm on the port side with twin crew chairs and side door to the starboard deck. To the port side a very well appointed office desk space runs across and down the port side either for owner or captain's work station, with grey leather top and drawers detailing.

Working our way down stairs we find our way to the lower companionway with access to the 4 guest cabins and also day head and utility area. Moving aft we arrive to the full beam midships owner's cabin, with ensuite on the port side and walk-in wardrobe on the port side, the full sized panoramic hull windows fill the cabin with natural light and amazing views. The ensuite with full size shower and impressive interior styling with large full width mirror complement the space and the cabin.

Moving up through the boat we have the twin cabin to the port side, this cabin shares the ensuite from the starboard double cabin with access off of the companionway forward. To the port side we have the spacious port double cabin with ensuite the angled arrangement creating a full walk-around of the bed. Forward is the VIP forward cabin, vanity area to the port side as you walk in and ensuite to the starboard side.

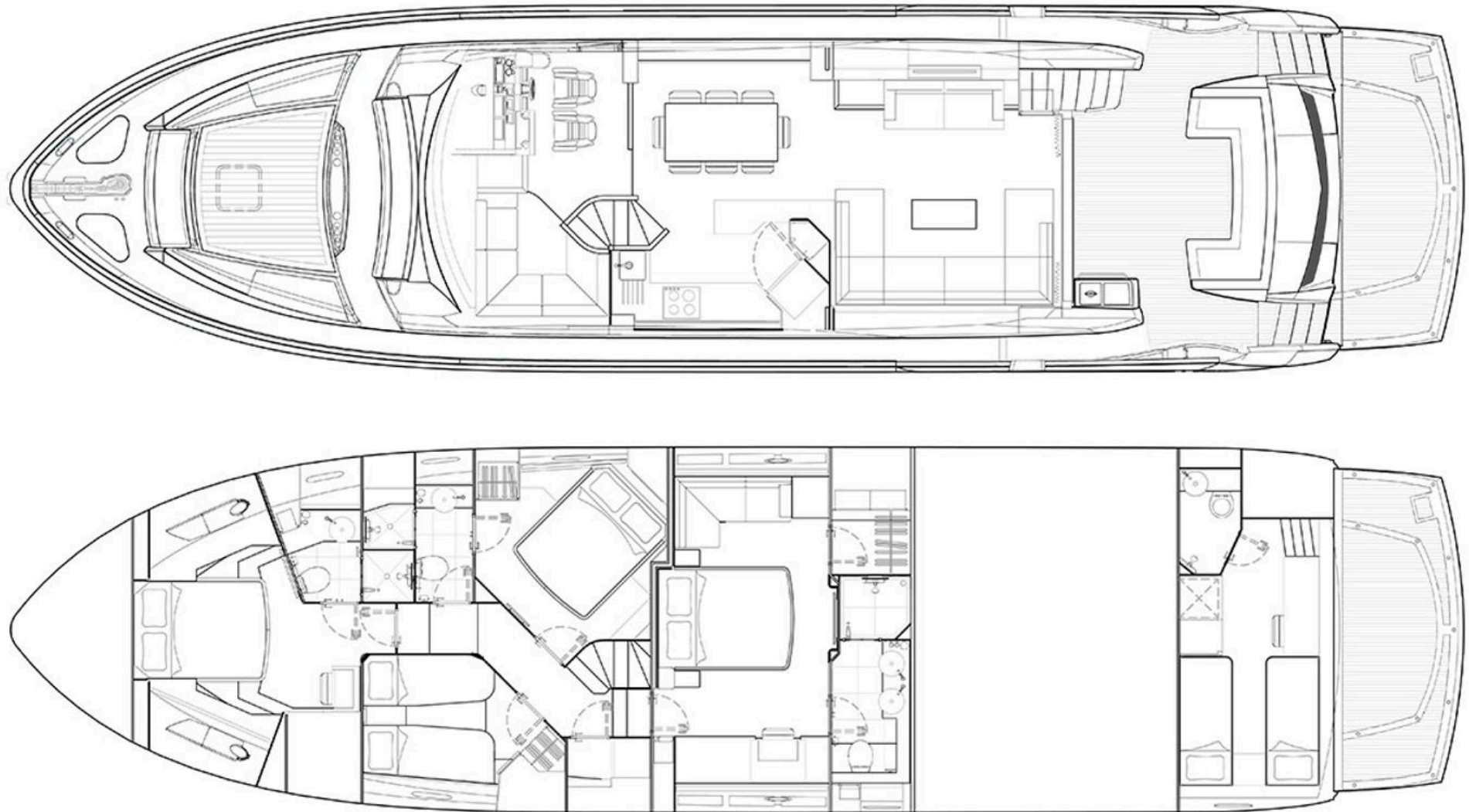
